

## The Distinguished Club Program (DCP)

Toastmasters International has an annual Distinguished Club Program that runs from July 1 through June 30. DCP focuses on both membership and educational achievements. At the end of each Toastmaster year, clubs receive recognition based on the number of goals your club met.

### DCP Goals:

Meet **9 Goals** you are **Presidents Distinguished**.

Meet **7 Goals**, you earn **Select Distinguished honor**.

Meet **5 Goals** and you are a **Distinguished Club**.

### Membership Requirement

To be eligible for any DCP awards, a club must end the Toastmasters year, which is June 30, with 20 or more members OR a net increase of at least 5 members over the number of members it had at the beginning of the Toastmaster year.
